Pauline Barrett's grand-uncle was James Flynn from Cuilnakillew, one of the Addergoole Fourteen who was lost when RMS Titanic sank.

Pauline recalls:

“My grandmother told me that her brother, Jim, was a good swimmer. They lived close to Lough Conn. He tried to get into Lifeboat 16 and was pushed away by an oar.”
